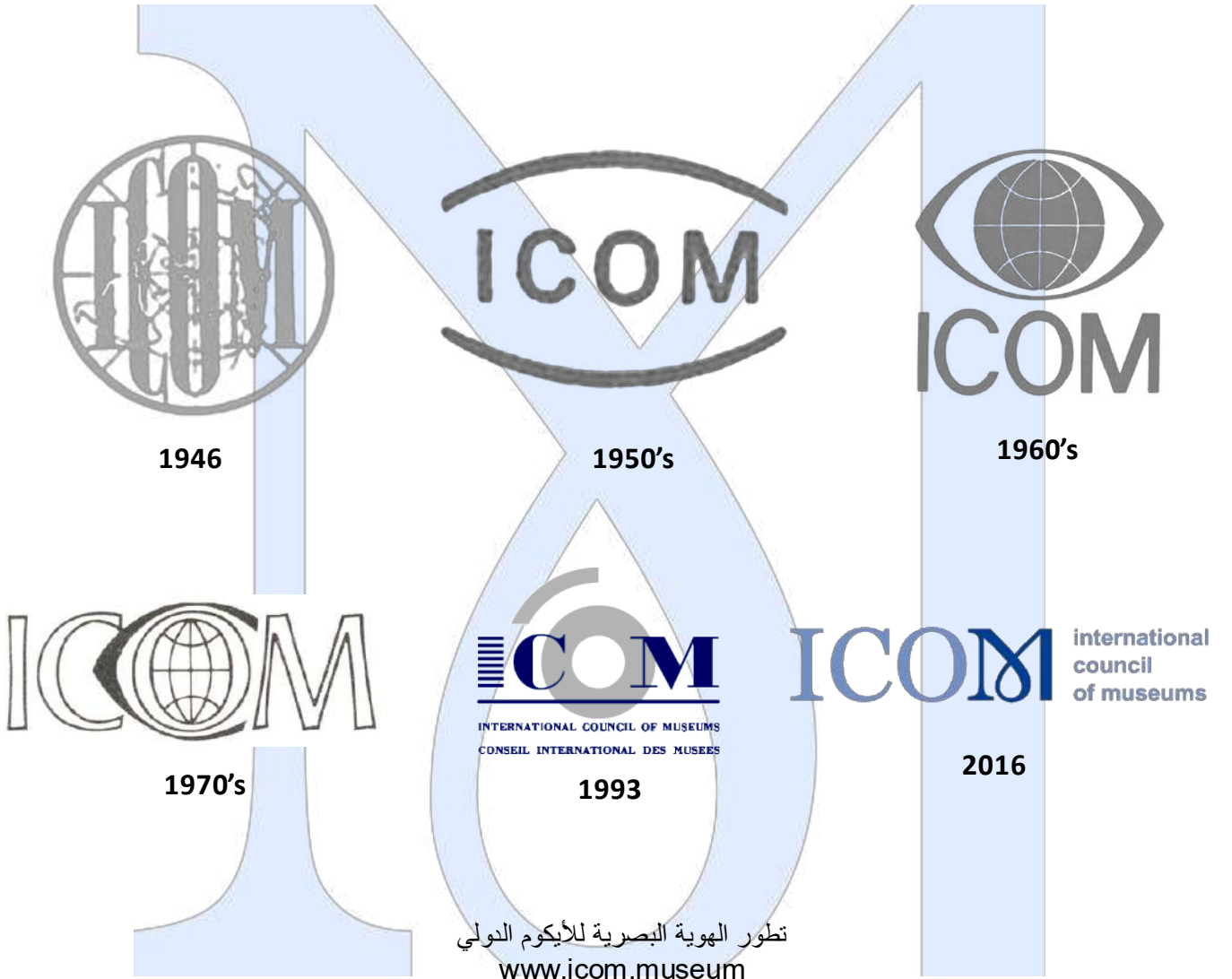

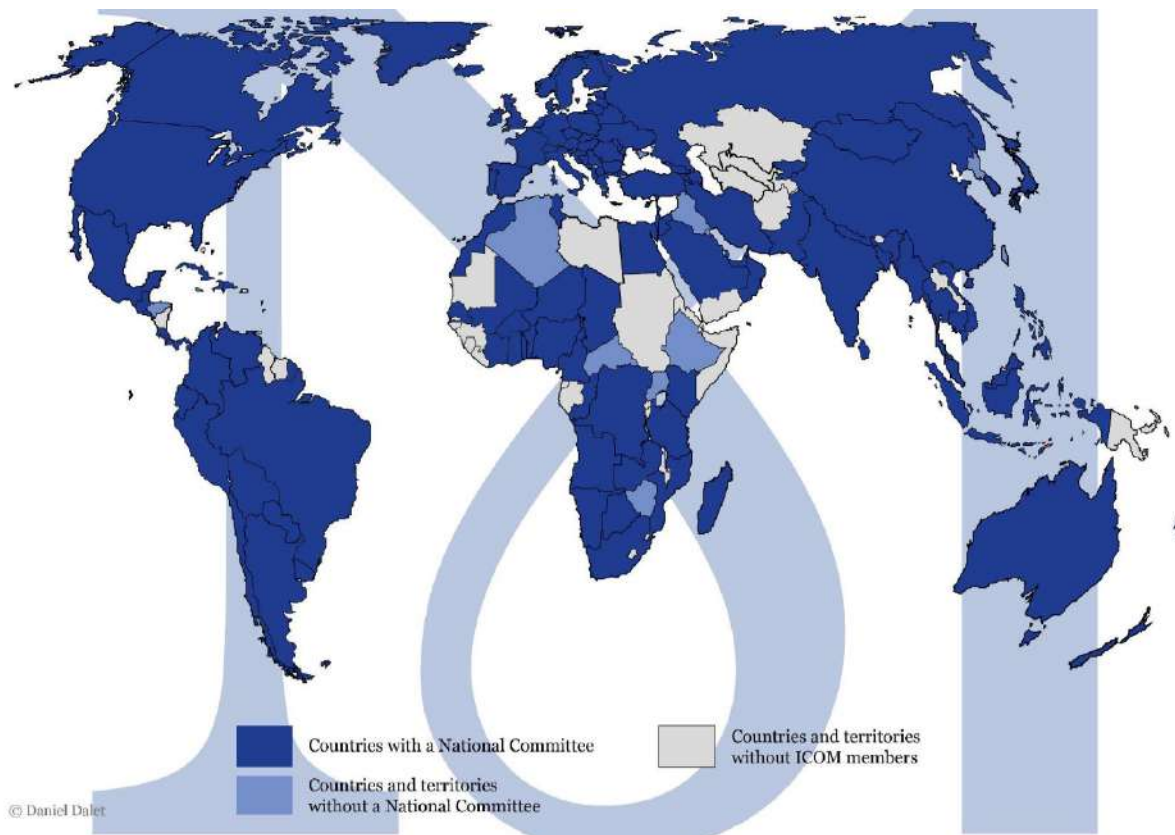
المجلس الدولي للمتاحف 1946

تم تأسيس المجلس الدولي للمتاحف في نونبر 1946 على هامش المؤتمر الأول لمنظمة اليونسكو. أصبح المجلس حالياً أكبر تجمع عالمي للمتخصصين في العالمي، يتوفر على أكثر من 60.400 عضو من 139 دولة، و120 لجنة وطنية، 34 لجنة دولية متخصصة، 7 اتحادات جهوية مثل الأيكوم العربي و21 منظمة منتسبة للأيكوم. 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أنواع العضوية بالمجلس الدولي للمتاحف/الأيكوم الدولي

يتم تقديم طلب العضوية حصريا عبر اللجان الوطنية، فإن حالة عدم وجود لجنة وطنية يتم التواصل مع سكرتارية الأيكوم مباشرة.

1- العضوية الفردية:

* **المهنيون والمهتمون بالتراث الثقافي:** الذين يشتغلون بالمتاحف وكذلك المتقاعدين، الأشخاص المهتمين بالمتاحف والتراث الثقافي الذين لا يمارسون الاتجار بالأعمال الفنية والتراثية. العضوية الفردية تخول الحصول على بطاقة واحدة تحمل اسم الشخص.

* **عضوية الطلبة:** الطلبة الذين يدرسون علم المتاحف بشكل خاص والتراث الثقافي بشكل عام، وتخول الحصول على بطاقة واحدة تحمل اسم الطالب.

* **عضوية الداعمين:** الأشخاص أو المؤسسات التي قدمت خدمات ملموسة سواء كانت مادية أو غير مادية للأيكوم ارتباطا باهتمامها بالمتاحف وبالتعاون الدولي بين المتاحف. الأشخاص يحصلون على بطاقة عضوية والمؤسسات ثمان بطاقات.

* **العضوية الشرفية:** شخصيات قدمت خدمات كبيرة للأيكوم وللمتاحف في العالم، وعلى الجمعية العمومية أن تعتمد هذا النوع من العضوية.

2- **العضوية المؤسسية:** المتاحف أو المؤسسات التي ينطبق عليها تعريف المتحف المعتمد من طرف الأيكوم ومؤسسات أخرى تنطبق عليها بعض مميزات المتحف يتم اعتمادها بعد قرار للمجلس الاستشاري للأيكوم. هذه العضوية تخول الحصول على ثلاثة بطاقات تحمل اسم المؤسسة وقد تصل إلى ثمان بطاقات حسب التصنيفات المرتبطة بحجم ميزانية تشغيل المؤسسة.

2.2 - Individual members

All those who in a professional manner practice tasks within the scope of a museum qualify for ICOM membership.

The tasks do not require a specific managerial or academic level. However, in the case of volunteers, time use and professionalism must correspond to a museum employee's.

" المتحف مؤسسة دائمة غير ربحية في خدمة المجتمع، يقوم بالبحث وجمع وصون وتفسير وعرض التراث المادي وغير المادي، مفتوح للجمهور، متاح وشامل ومعزز للتنوع والاستدامة. تعمل المتاحف وتتواصل بطريقة أخلاقية ومهنية بمشاركة المجتمعات المختلفة لتقديم تجارب متنوعة في التربية والاستمتاع والتأمل وتبادل المعرفة."

" A museum is a not-for-profit, permanent institution in the service of society that researches, collects, conserves, interprets and exhibits tangible and intangible heritage. Open to the public, accessible and inclusive, museums foster diversity and sustainability. They operate and communicate ethically, professionally and with the participation of communities, offering varied experiences for education, enjoyment, reflection and knowledge sharing."

2.1 - Institutional Members

2.1.1 Institutional Members Definition

Institutional Members are defined as museums or other institutions that comply with the definition of a museum as outlined in the Statutes as well as that which is defined in the following.

2.1.2 Institutions qualifying as museums

Aside from institutions designated as museums, the following institutions qualify as museums eligible to seek ICOM membership:

- i. Natural, archaeological and ethnographic monuments and sites, historical monuments and sites requiring the execution of museum-related activities including acquisition, conservation, and the collection of tangible and intangible evidence of peoples and their environment;
- ii. Institutions holding collections and displaying for educational purposes live specimens of plants and animals, such as botanical and zoological gardens, aquaria and vivaria;
- iii. Science centres and planetaria;
- iv. Non-profit art galleries, as well as conservation institutes and exhibition galleries maintained by libraries and archive centres;
- v. Nature reserves;
- vi. National, regional or local museum organisations as well as public agencies (ministries, departments or organisations) responsible for museums as defined in the present Article;
- vii. Non-profit institutions or organisations undertaking research in areas of conservation, education, training, documentation, as well as other activities relating to museums and museology;
- viii. Cultural centres and other institutions that facilitate the preservation, perpetuation and management of tangible and intangible heritage resources including living heritage and the creation of digital artefacts.

2.1.3 Non-profit

The expression "non-profit" describes an organisation whose surplus funds are applied exclusively to promoting its stated purpose and to ensuring its operation.

(Article 2-1-3, ICOM Internal rules, Amended by the Extraordinary Executive Board on 9th June 2017, Paris, France)

- طابع الديمومة للمؤسسة المتحفية كمرفق عام، يجب أن يكون مفتوحاً للجمهور بصفة منتظمة .
- تفضيل خدمة المجتمع على الكسب المادي وعدم المتاجرة في التحف.
- اتباع سياسات محددة لعملية اقتناء التحف، والمحافظة عليها، والقيام بدراسات وبحوث بشأنها.
- الحفاظ على التراث المادي واللامادي للمجتمع والعناية بالمجموعات ونقلها إلى الأجيال المقبلة.
- عدم إغفال جانب المتعة الذي يجب توفيره للزوار داخل فضاءات المتحف.

حقوق ممثلي المؤسسة في لجان الأيكوم

- يمكن للمؤسسات المنتمية للأيكوم تعيين **ثلاثة ممثلين لها** بلجان الأيكوم التي يختارون الانتماء إليها (اللجان الوطنية وباقي اللجان والاتحادات).
- لديهم حق التصويت والترشح داخل هذه اللجان ما داموا ينتمون لنفس المؤسسة.
- لديهم حق التصويت في الجمعية العمومية للأيكوم الدولي واجتماعات مجلسه الاستشاري عندما يكونون **معينين رسميا من طرف اللجان** التي ينتمون إليها.
- ليس لديهم حق الترشح **للمكتب التنفيذي للأيكوم** إلا بعد حصولهم على **العضوية الفردية**.
- وبعد **تعيينهم من طرف لجنة ينتمون** إليها ليكونوا مرشحين باسمها.

Institutional Members can designate three (3) persons to represent them on National Committees and International Committees, as well as at the General Conference and General Assembly. These persons need not be Individual Members of ICOM.

The names of the designated representatives shall be conveyed to the Chairpersons or to the Director General in writing signed by the head of the Institution concerned according to the circumstances at hand.

Criteria for membership
 Membership in ICOM is open to museums, institutions recognised by ICOM* and museum professionals, according to the criteria laid out in the association's Statutes.

“A museum is a non-profit, permanent institution in the service of society and its development, open to the public, which acquires, conserves, researches, communicates and exhibits the tangible and intangible heritage of humanity and its environment for the purposes of education, study and enjoyment.”

“Museum professionals include all staff of the museums and institutions (recognised by ICOM), and persons who, in a professional capacity, have as their main activity to provide services, knowledge and expertise for museums and the museum community.”

All persons and institutions applying for ICOM membership shall agree

- Not to trade in cultural property, works of art or natural and scientific specimens.
- To adhere to the ICOM Code of Ethics for Museums.
- To send their written application form to the National Committee of their country of residence.
- To pay an annual membership fee at a rate determined by ICOM.

ARTICLE 6. RULES FOR NATIONAL COMMITTEES

6.1 - Roles and Responsibilities

A National Committee shall ensure the management of ICOM's interests within its State, represent the interests of its members within ICOM, including matters of a professional nature with which the National Committee is concerned, and contribute to the realization of ICOM's programmes.

Each National Committee is represented at the ICOM Advisory Council by its Chair or representative, and is represented at the ICOM General Assembly as determined by the ICOM Statutes and Internal Rules.

A National Committee shall be a primary channel of communication between the members and ICOM headquarters, and shall in particular be responsible for:

- the promotion of membership of ICOM among professional museum workers and museums in that State;

.....

- the collecting of annual subscriptions on behalf of ICOM and their transmission to the Secretariat.

6.2 - Membership

If there is no National Committee in a State, an Individual Member resident in that State may, with the agreement of the National Committee of another State, and with the approval of the Executive Board, affiliate with that National Committee and participate in its affairs as if a resident of that other State. Such affiliation will cease automatically should a National Committee be established in the State of residence.

Individual members in a State without National Committee shall within ICOM be communicated to as a group, receiving the same information as the National Committees, and be encouraged to work together as a group and eventually be able to form a National Committee.

تكوين لجنة وطنية للأيكوم في خمس خطوات

- 1- يتم تكوين لجنة وطنية جديدة من طرف **ثمانية أعضاء فرديين في الأيكوم** على الأقل مقيمين في نفس الدولة.
- 2- يقوم الأعضاء **باجتماع تحضيرى وإرسال طلب رسمي لتكوين اللجنة** إلى مدير الأيكوم الدولي بباريس مباشرة أو عن طريق الأيكوم العربي **يحمل إمضاء الأعضاء**.
- 3- بعد التوصل بقرار الموافقة من طرف المكتب التنفيذي للأيكوم يتم تنظيم **جمعية عمومية تأسيسية** ويتم انتخاب **مكتب تنفيذي** للجنة الوطنية. يمكن أن تكون تشكيلة المكتب كالتالي: الرئيس/ نائب أو نواب الرئيس/ الأمين العام- مساعد الأمين العام/ أمين الصندوق – مساعد أمين الصندوق/ الأعضاء، غير أن للجنة الوطنية الحق في اعتماد أي صيغة أخرى مناسبة لوضعها وللقوانين الوطنية.
- 4- بعد انتخاب المكتب يتم إرسال **محضر الجمعية العمومية** ونسخة من النظام الأساسي للجنة إلى مدير الأيكوم الدولي بباريس لحفظ النتائج ونشرها.
- 5- اللجان الوطنية هي **جمعيات غير حكومية** ممثلة **لأيكوم الدولي** وملتزمة بأنظمتها ومطالبة أيضا **بالالتزام بالقوانين الوطنية** ذات الصلة في البلد المسجلة فيه.

6.3 - Establishing a National Committee

A National Committee may be established in any State by the Executive Board on receipt of a request in writing to the Director-General signed by at least eight (8) Individual or Institutional Members of ICOM residing in the State concerned.

Upon receipt of such a request, the Director-General shall inform all members of ICOM residing in the State concerned of the proposal, and invite their comments. The Director-General shall transmit the request together with any comments thereon from ICOM members residing in that State to the Executive Board for decision.

If the Executive Board decides to establish a National Committee, the Director-General shall advise all the members residing in the State concerned and shall designate one of the members to arrange and chair the first meeting of the Committee at which election of the Chair and members of the Board shall take place and Rules be adopted.

The Chair elected at the first meeting shall convey the minutes of the meeting to the Director-General at the earliest opportunity together with a copy of their Rules and the names and addresses of members of the Board.

Creation of an ICOM National Committee

Two (2) Prerequisites:

UN Member State*

Eight (8) members
in good standing

- The adoption of its own National Committee Rules;
- The registration of an independent, non-governmental, non-profit legal entity with the appropriate national authorities;
- The opening of a unique bank account for the National Committee;
- The regular organization and holding of plenary meetings and Executive Board elections;
- Having a minimum of eight (8) members constituting the National Committee.

Failure to comply with one or more of these rules could jeopardize the functioning of the National Committee.

"The Executive Board may decide to suspend the rights of a National Committee [...] if there is evidence that the Committee is no longer functioning effectively. [...] A National Committee whose number of members falls below the minimum will be considered under reorganisation and its voting right will be suspended in the Advisory Council and General Assembly until the number of members has reached the required minimum." ICOM Internal Rules (Article 6.5).

6.3 - Establishing a National Committee

A National Committee may be established in any State by the Executive Board on receipt of a request in writing to the Director-General signed by at least eight (8) Individual or Institutional Members of ICOM residing in the State concerned.

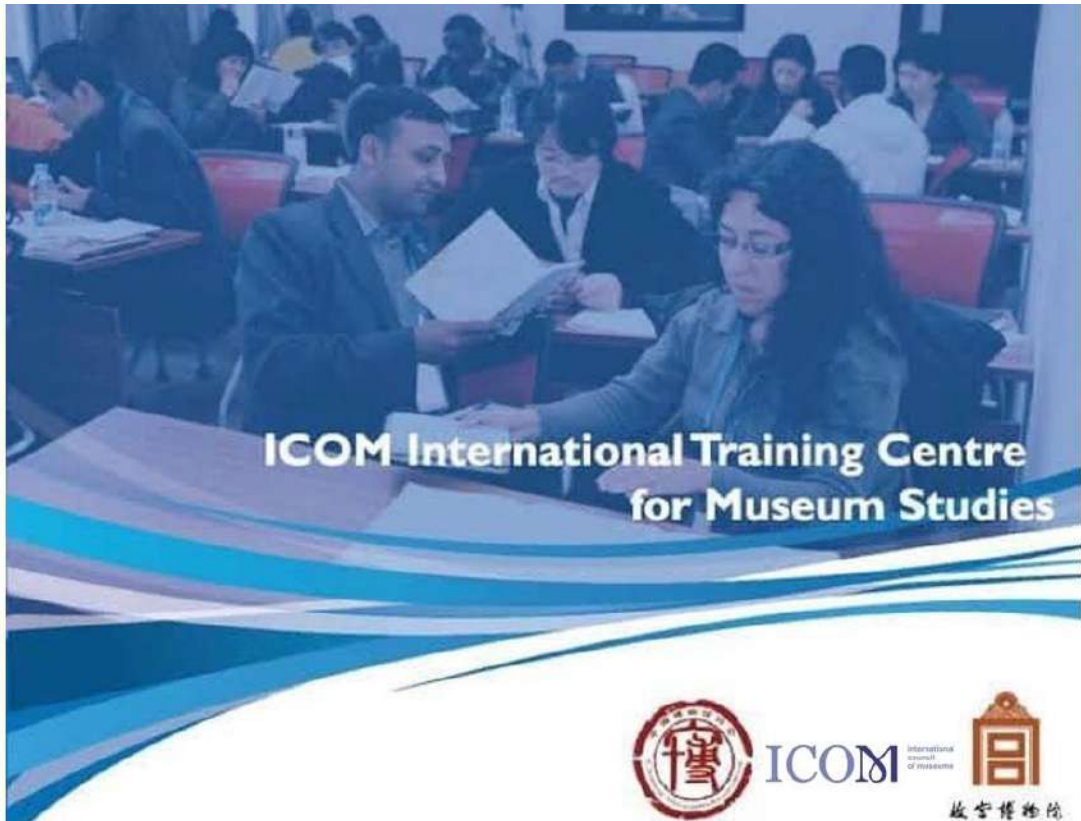

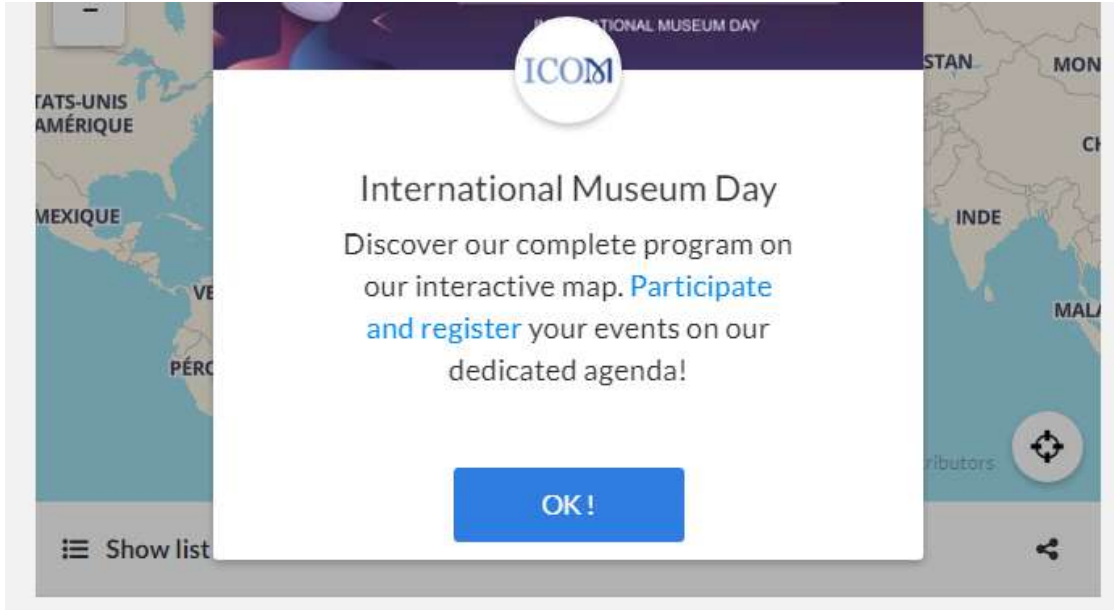

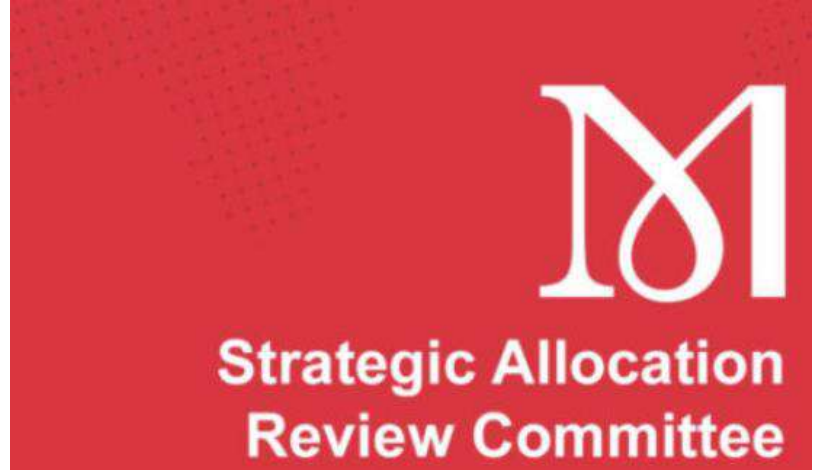

2. MEMBERSHIP RATES

Article 5, section 1, of the *ICOM Statutes* states that “the rate [of the annual membership fee] is stipulated by the Executive Board and approved by the General Assembly”. These annual membership fees must be paid **in Euro** by the National Committee to the Secretariat's account.

“In addition to the annual subscription determined by the Executive Board the National Committee may impose **a surcharge** that shall be clearly identified as such for the purposes of the National Committee”, according to article 4 (b) of the *Rules for National Committees*. This surcharge may also be used by the National Committee to cover the bank charges related to the transfer of dues to the Secretariat, in particular in case of fluctuations in the exchange rate.

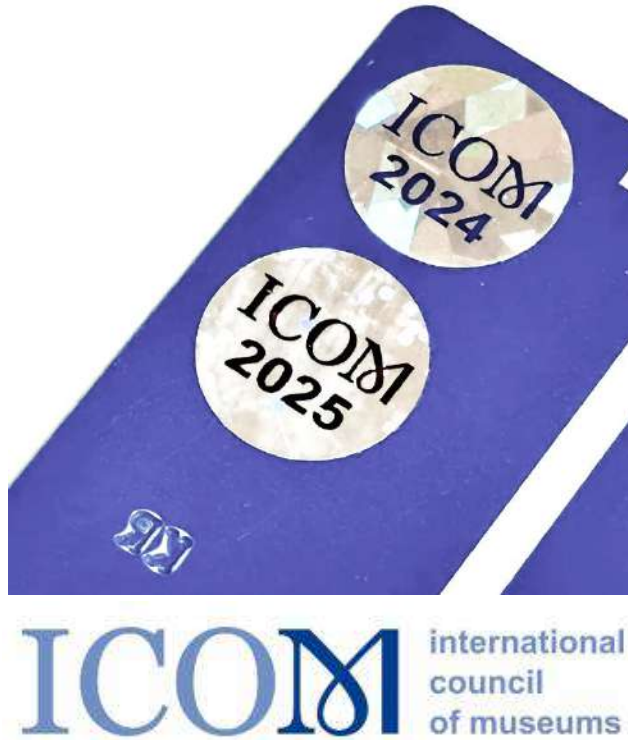
STATUTORY RULES AND PROCEDURES

1. LEGAL STATUS AND BANK ACCOUNT

The statutory documents of ICOM define precisely the legal status of a National Committee, which must be **a separate legal entity** (*ICOM Statutes*, article 14), **a non-profit organisation** (*ICOM Statutes*, article 1, section 2) as well as **a non-governmental organisation** (*Rules for National Committees*, article 1.b.), according to the national law of the State concerned.

According to article 5 (d) of the *Rules for National Committees*, “all money received by the National Committee shall be deposited in **a bank account established for the purpose** and all payments made on behalf of the Committee shall be made from that bank account”, as a National Committee of ICOM is a separate legal entity. Therefore, a National Committee may not use a private bank account (in the name of the Chair, the Treasurer or other person) to receive dues or to transfer them to the Secretariat's account.

3. PERIOD COVERED BY THE MEMBERSHIP FEES

The membership is annual and covers the calendar year in question, **from 1st January to 31st December** (article 5.2. of the *Statutes of ICOM*). Unless members specify otherwise, all dues received after 30 September will cover the membership fee for the following year.

4. ANNUAL STICKERS

“Each year upon receipt of the amount notified to an existing member, the National Committee shall provide the member with **a sticker** for attachment to the ICOM card **indicating that the subscription for the current year has been paid**” (*Rules for National Committees*, article 4.e.).

The 2022 stickers will be available from 1st October 2021 upon request, by filling out the attached form and sending it to the Membership Department, before 31st December 2021, along with any unused 2021 stickers and all outstanding dues.

Criteria for membership

Membership in ICOM is open to museums, institutions recognised by ICOM* and museum professionals, according to the criteria laid out in the association's *Statutes*:

“A museum is a non-profit, permanent institution in the service of society and its development, open to the public, which acquires, conserves, researches, communicated and exhibits the tangible and intangible heritage of humanity and its environment for the purposes of education, study and enjoyment

Museum professionals include all staff [recognised by ICOM], and persons who, in a professional capacity, have as their main activity to provide services, knowledge and expertise for museums and the museum community.”

All persons and institutions applying for ICOM membership shall agree

- Not to trade in cultural property, works of art or natural and scientific specimens.
- To adhere to the *ICOM Code of Ethics for Museums*.
- To send their written application form to the National Committee of their country of residence.
- To pay an annual membership fee at a rate determined by ICOM.

***ICOM Internal Rules, Article 2.1.2. Institutions qualifying as museums**

"Aside from institutions designated as museums, the following institutions qualify as museums eligible to seek ICOM membership: **I.** Natural, archaeological and ethnographic monuments and sites, historical monuments and sites requiring the execution of museum-related activities including acquisition, conservation, and the collection of tangible and intangible evidence of peoples and their environment; **II.** Institutions holding collections and displaying for educational purposes live specimens of plants and animals, such as botanical and zoological gardens, aquaria and vivaria; **III.** Science centres and planetaria; **IV.** Non-profit art galleries, as well as conservation institutes and exhibition galleries maintained by libraries and archive centres; **V.** Nature reserves; **VI.** National, regional or local museum organisations as well as public agencies (ministries, departments or organisations) responsible for museums as defined in the present Article; **VII.** Non-profit institutions or organisations undertaking research in areas of conservation, education, training, documentation, as well as other activities relating to museums and museology; **VIII.** Cultural centres and other institutions that facilitate the preservation, perpetuation and management of tangible and intangible heritage resources including living heritage and the creation of digital artefacts."

**Including your date of birth is optional for membership but required for receiving certain grants.
